Laurie Traktman is a partner at the labor law firm of Gilbert & Sackman. She is a long-standing active officer of the Chapter and has been a producer of the Chapter's radio show (The Lawyers Guild Show) on KPFK for the past seventeen

years. Laurie is a well-known political activist on behalf of many progressive causes and political candidates.

Alison Cooper-Boberg has co-produced the Chapter's radio show for several years, with a special focus on highlighting environmental issues. Active in education, as well as environmental and political causes, her work in the public school system resulted in the Lori Petrick Excellence in Teaching Award, an annual monetary award that recognizes teachers who go the extra mile to inspire the children they teach.

Betty Hung is a long-time leader in the struggle for low wage and immigrant workers. In recent years, despite vicious taxi company attacks, Betty has partnered with the Los Angeles Taxi Workers Alliance to fight taxi cab company corruption and worker exploitation. Betty is a Senior Attorney at the Legal Aid Foundation of Los Angeles and volunteer Special Counsel at the Inner City Law Center.

The L.A.-based **Asociación de Loncheros L.A. Familia Unida de California** was formed to protect the rights of catering food truck owners and operators, as well as preserve the "Lonchera" industry throughout Southern California and abroad. Accordingly, they believe their industry is an economic and socio-cultural asset to the communities it serves.

Jan Goodman and Jerry Manpearl are this year's recipients of the Hon. Robert W. Kenny Award. Jan Goodman is a former Chair of the LA/NLG, and former Regional Vice-President of the NLG. She is co-founder and executive Director of the Paul Robeson Community Center, and was a member of the KPFK station board until this year. She is the past president of Sunset Hall and the Southern Calif. Chapter of Americans for Democratic Action. Jerry Manpearl, was an active member of the Berkeley protests against HUAC, a trial lawyer for the ACLU following the Watts uprising, and a lawyer for the anti-war demonstrators beaten by the police at Century Plaza Hotel. He was co-founder and board member of the Museum of African Art and the Paul Robeson Community Center, president of the So. Calif. Trade Association and has served on boards of directors such as Americans for Democratic Action and the Alcott Center for Mental Health.

Hon. Robert Kenny was a California State Senator, an Attorney General of the State of California, and from 1940-1948, President of the National Lawyers Guild.

The National Lawyers Guild has been fighting for social equality and economic justice for over 70 years on behalf of our belief that human rights are more sacred than property interests.
